Servant Ministry's budget for 2013 was 4% of All Saints' annual income. The Servant Ministry Committee's mission is to reach out to persons in need within our parish, community, state, nation and world. As a committee we prayerfully voted to spend the budget as follows:

19% was spent on monetary donations to nonprofit organizations in our community: Faith Haven, Gardener Simmons, Good Samaritan Clinic, NCADD, Regional Rehab, Sanctuary Hospice, Shepherd Center, Special Olympics Tupelo, Tree of Life Clinic, Walk for Alzheimer's, Weekend Food Backpack program, and Women First Resource Center.

18 % was spent on International Outreach: Honduras Medical Mission, Episcopal Relief & Development, and Twic East Relief in South Sudan.

18% was spent on parishioners' needs.

14% was given to the Rector & Curate Discretionary Funds to be distributed to the needy in our community.

The committee spent \$1500 on scholarship funds for parish youth to attend Camp Bratton-Green and other diocesan youth gatherings.

We sponsored one needy child through the CASA program.

The committee donated \$1000 to the Gray Center.

We assisted two families with medical bill payments.

Servant Ministry funded the Saints' Brew Christmas dinner.

For most of 2013 Saints' Brew operated under Servant Ministry. Saints' Brew continues to fund itself through contributions. We saw the average number of daily meals served rise to 100. Saints' Brew is now a separate committee that will continue in 2014 under the leadership of co-chairs Mona Warlick and Beth Harris.

Neighborhood Life, chaired by Susan Hyatt, is also a subcommittee of Servant Ministry. NL was busy: Sponsored an Outdoor Pentecost service, collected Kroger bags for Saints' Brew, sponsored a Health & Resource Fair for Saints' Brew, participated in planning Trunk or Treat with area downtown Churches (event has to be cancelled due to weather), Served hot chocolate in front of the church during the Christmas parade, and held the Saints' Brew Christmas Party.
